The Library contains all the published works of Rudolf Steiner in English translation and in the original German (*Die Gesamtausgabe*), also typescript translations of many unpublished lectures. There is also a small collection of basic Steiner works in French, Italian and Spanish and an assortment of other languages. All works in English by other anthroposophical authors are held, also some in German and other languages. Journals and Newsletters are kept (plus back numbers) in English, German, French and Dutch, some of which can be borrowed. We have a number of general books relevant to Anthroposophy including History, Philosophy, Biography, Poetry, Drama, Mythology, Occultism, Freemasonry, Alternative Technology and Sciences.

Videos on Steiner based initiatives and some tapes of Steiner lectures are also available. Reference material on the history of the movement, archives, prints and photographs may also be consulted.

Prospective borrowers who are not members of the Anthroposophical Society are asked to furnish proof of address and the signature of a referee. This should be a responsible person such as a course tutor or principal, or a potential passport signatory, or a member of the Anthroposophical Society who has known the borrower for at least six months.

Four books may be borrowed at any time for one month initially, generally renewable, and a longer loan may be requested for books for study purposes. An administrative charge of 30p per book or £10 per year is levied. A postal service also operates with a charge for postage and packing. The library staff are always willing to answer queries, advise with reading or trace references.
