The 19 Mantras of the School of Spiritual Science

Dear Friends

You are warmly invited to a conference to be held at Rudolf Steiner House, London, offered by the General Section of the School of Spiritual Science in Great Britain in collaboration with the School of Spiritual Science at the Goetheanum.

This conference will take us through the wholeness of the path of the 19 mantras of the 1st Class of the School of Spiritual Science. Its focus will be the transformation of our consciousness, mantra 14 and the question of how to discern and relate to spiritual beings who wish to work with us on the essential tasks of our world today and tomorrow.

Class holders will give free renderings of the 19 mantras, inspired by the mood of mantra 14. There will be a choice of themed groups where questions and perspectives relating to the conference theme will be developed over three days. There will also be daily conversation groups to reflect on the mantric content and to share questions, inspirations and insights. There will be optional early morning singing, and Bothmer movement or eurythmy in the early afternoon.

Each day will start with a short eurythmy performance by Maren Stott, Principal of Eurythmy West Midlands and a member of the Goetheanum Eurythmy Ensemble.

The design of the 5 days leaves ample space for participants to socialise and work together in smaller groups. The extended lunch breaks create opportunities for relaxation in nearby Regent's Park, exploration in London or rest at Rudolf Steiner House.

As with the previous conference in August, 2019 "The Nineteen Class Lessons – New Perspectives on Destiny", we again look forward to welcoming members of the School of Spiritual Science both from Great Britain and from around the world.
